Course Location: Online (Optional workshops/testing available at the University of Washington Seattle Campus during the summer, fall, and winter.)

Application Deadline: None. Will begin accepting applications on Mach 1, 2008.

Student Notification: Students will be notified via e-mail approximately two weeks after EAN receives the application. PLEASE BE SURE TO INCLUDE A LEGIBLE AND VALID EMAIL ADDRESS ON YOUR APPLICATION FORM.

Refund Policy: No refund five (5) business days after receipt of application.

Refundable Deposit: A refundable deposit is required from all students OR may be submitted by a sponsoring program on behalf of a student.

1. ONLINE COURSE (Select One or Both Below): Students who select this course option will have access to a complete online SAT and/or ACT course from March 2008 – March 2009, but may sign up at any time during this time period. Eligible students may make payment arrangements.

SUBJECT REVIEW WORKSHOPS (Optional): (Students with the following scores should take the subject review workshops: 500 or below on the SAT verbal, SAT Math, and/or SAT Writing OR 21 or below on the ACT English, Math, Science, and/or Reading. Students may focus on all math/science or all verbal/writing OR can review both math-science and verbal-writing.) 5. COLLEGE PLANNING AND FINANCIAL PLANNING WORKSHOPS (Optional): Student (and parents) may attend the following workshops: 1. Introduction to College Planning/Selection; 2. Introduction to Preparing the College Admissions Application; 3. Introduction to Writing the College Admissions Essay; 4. Introduction to Financial Planning (*i.e.*, Financial Aid, financial literacy, etc.); 5. Introduction to locating Scholarships and Preparing the Applications; and 6.
