GENERAL INFORMATION: The mission of Education Access Network ("EAN") is to provide students with free and affordable access to courses and programs aimed at helping students prepare for and succeed in higher education and other academic endeavors. EAN believes that limited financial resources should never restrict a student's access to educational opportunities. The classes are held primarily on the University of Washington Seattle campus.

COURSE NAME: **SAT/ACT Preparation & College Planning** (Students who select this course option will use the lesson book from KAPLAN's comprehensive test preparation course. In addition, EAN materials will be provided free of charge. Students also will have access to a free online program that is monitored by EAN teachers.)

COURSE FEE: **\$145** (Required unless a tuition waiver/alternative payment arrangement is requested.)

TUITION WAIVER: If you are requesting a tuition waiver or wish to make payment arrangement, please indicate your request in the 2009 General Application form and complete the Request for Tuition Waiver/Payment Arrangement form.

REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT: **\$150** (Required even if a tuition waiver/payment arrangement is requested.)

DEPOSIT POLICY: The deposit check will NOT be cashed and/or the credit card will NOT be processed upon application. The original deposit check or Credit Card Authorization form will be destroyed if the student returns the course materials by the deadline (undamaged and in good condition) as specified by EAN and the student completes the following minimum course requirements:

- ✓ Student must complete 100% of all examinations (in-class or at home)
- ✓ Student must complete 80% of all assignments and quizzes
- ✓ Student must complete all EAN surveys
- ✓ Student may not miss more than 12 class hours.
- ✓ Student must return all course material to our offices by **Tuesday, December 8, 2009** unless the student provides written notification that he or she intends to take the SAT or ACT in January, February, or March 2010.
- ✓ Student is expected to provide EAN with copies of all official standardized tests taken (i.e., SAT, ACT, etc.) in 2009.

Note: Education Access Network will cash the refundable deposit check or process the credit card identified in the Credit Card Authorization form if the student keeps his or her books after the December 8, 2009 deadline or if the student notifies EAN of his or her intent to purchase the course materials. Also note that if a student withdraws his or her application or withdraws from the class after the application deadline (July 3, 2009), the student will lose \$50 of his or her deposit. Exceptions: Death in family, severe illness, medical emergency, etc.

If the student is unable to provide a deposit check or a Credit Card Authorization form due to individual circumstances, please contact Education Access Network to discuss deposit alternatives.
